

For each name that is standing there like a road indicator, like a palm tree in the desert of this world, a search through the whole Bible was done to show the eternal value of that name, in the past, present and future times.

When touching the texts in bold, the glossary of over 600 names and titles can be opened. It is very easy then to search in the Bible and find the names in their original context. The quotations are used only once.

Before the creation of the world



Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and to the ages to come.

Hebrews 13, 8

I Am Jesus

- John 8, 58 Jesus said to them: I tell you the truth, before Abraham was, I am.
- Exodus 3, 14 **I am that I am.** This is what you are to say to the children of Israel: "I am has sent me to you."
- Deuteronomy 32, 39 See now that I, I am HE (*The Same, the self-existent one. This expression becomes virtually a name of God*), and there is no god with me.
- Nehemiah 9, 5 Let men bless the name of your glory, which is exalted above all blessing and praise.
- Psalms 102, 27 You are the Same, (*literally 'You He' a name of God, 'The existing One, who does not change'*) and your years will never end.
- Isaiah 9, 6e His name is called Father of Eternity (*Father of the age*).
- Isaiah 41, 4 Who has done this and carried it through, calling the generations from the beginning? I, the LORD, the first; and with the last, I am HE (*or I, the Same, it is really a name of God*).
- Micah 5, 2 The one who is to be Ruler in Israel will come for me: whose origins are from of old, from the days of eternity.
- John 17, 5 "Glorify me, Father, along with yourself, with the glory I had along with you before the world was."
- Colossians 1, 17 He is before all and all things subsist together by him.
- James 1, 17 Every good and perfect gift (*freely given*) comes down from above, from the Father of lights, with whom is no variation nor shadow of turning.
- Revelation 1, 4a Grace to you and peace from him who is (*essential nature of his being*), who was and who is to come (the coming one).

The Word

Jesus

- John 1, 1 In the beginning was the Word. The Word was with God and the Word was God.
- Psalms 33, 9 He spoke and it was done; he commanded and it stood fast.
- Isaiah 40, 8 The grass withers and the flowers fall; but the word of our God endures for ever.
- John 1, 3 All things received being through him and without him not one thing received being which has received being.
- John 1, 14a The Word became flesh and dwelt among us.
- John 6, 68 Simon Peter answered him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life."
- Romans 10, 17 Faith comes from hearing the message of God's word.
- Ephesians 6, 17 Have the sword of the Spirit, which is God's word.
- Hebrews 1, 3b Upholding all things by the word of his power.
- Hebrews 4, 12 The word of God is living and operative and sharper than any double-edged sword, a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.
- Hebrews 11, 3 The universe was formed by the word of God.
- 1 John 1, 1 That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes; that which we contemplated and our hands handled, concerning the Word of life.
- Revelation 19, 12b-13 He has a name written which no one knows but himself; he is dressed in a garment dipped in blood; his name is The Word of God.
- Revelation 19, 15 Coming out of his mouth is a sharp two-edged sword.


The Wisdom of God

Jesus

- 1 Corinthians 1, 24 Christ the power of God and the *Wisdom of God*.
- Proverbs 3, 19 By wisdom the LORD founded the earth; by understanding he established the heavens.
- Proverbs 8, 11 Wisdom is better than rubies and all the things that may be desired are not equal to it. Counsel is mine and sound wisdom: I am intelligence. I was set up (*anointed*) from eternity, from the beginning, before the earth was.
- Proverbs 8, 14
- Proverbs 8, 23
- Proverbs 8, 29-30 When the LORD appointed the foundations of the earth: then I was by him the nursling of his love (*or artist*).
- Isaiah 11, 2 The Spirit of the LORD will rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding.
- Luke 2, 40 The child grew and became strong in spirit, filled with wisdom, and God's grace was upon him.
- Matthew 11, 19b Wisdom has been justified by her children.
- Matthew 13, 54 The people of his hometown were astonished and said: "Where did this man get this wisdom and these works of power?"
- Romans 11, 33 O depth of riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable his judgments and untraceable his ways!
- 1 Corinthians 2, 7 We speak God's wisdom in a mystery, that hidden wisdom which God had predetermined before time began.
- Colossians 2, 2-3 The full knowledge of the mystery of God, in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and of knowledge.
- 1 John 3, 20 God is greater than our heart and knows all things.
- Revelation 13, 18 Here is wisdom (*or this calls for wisdom*).



God in the Old Testament



Jesus answered them: You search the Scriptures, because you think that in them you have eternal life. These are the very Scriptures that bear witness concerning me.

John 5, 39

Your Creator *Jesus*

- Ecclesiastes 12, 1 Remember your Creator in the days of your youth.
- Genesis 1, 1 In the beginning God (*Hebrew: Elohim, the plural of Eloah, the Supreme, it is 'Deity' in the absolute sense*) created the heavens and the earth.
- Isaiah 29, 16 Shall the potter be esteemed as the clay, so that the work should say of him that made it, "He made me not" or the thing formed say of him that formed it, "He has no understanding?"
- Isaiah 40, 28 The Lord, the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth, faints not nor tires. There is no searching of his understanding.
- Isaiah 43, 15 & 54, 5 The Creator of Israel. He is called the God of the whole earth.
- Isaiah 65, 17 See, I create new heavens and a new earth.
- Amos 4, 13 He who forms the mountains and creates the wind, and who declares to humankind what his thought is, the LORD, the God of hosts, is his name.
- Luke 22, 50-51 One of Jesus' followers struck the servant of the high priest cutting off his right ear, but Jesus having touched his ear, he healed him.
- Romans 1, 20 Since the world's creation the invisible things of God, both his eternal power and divinity (*what is characteristic of God*), are perceived, being apprehended by the mind through the things that are made.
- 2 Corinthians 5, 17 If anyone is in Christ, *that person* is a new creation.
- Hebrews 3, 4 Every house is built by someone; but he who has built all things is God. The city which has foundations, whose architect and builder is God (*or artificer and constructor*).
- Hebrews 11, 10

The LORD God

Jesus

- Genesis 2, 4 The LORD God (Jehovah, *Yahveh*) made the earth and the heavens.
- Exodus 9, 1 This is what the LORD, the God of the Hebrews, says: “Let my people go, so that they may serve me.”
- Exodus 34, 14 The LORD, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God.
- Deuteronomy 32, 8 When the Most High assigned to the nations their inheritance, when he divided all humankind, he set the boundaries for the peoples according to the number of the children of Israel (*or sons of God*).
- 1 Kings 18, 38 & 39 The fire of the LORD fell and burnt up the sacrifice. When all the people saw it, they fell on their faces and cried, “Jehovah, he is God! The LORD, he is God!”
- 2 Kings 2, 14 Elisha picked up the cloak that had fallen from Elijah and struck the water with it: “Where is the LORD, the God of Elijah?” he asked. When he struck the water, it divided to the right and to the left.
- Psalms 24, 7-8 Lift up your heads, you gates, be lifted up, you everlasting doors, and the King of glory will come in. Who is this King of glory? The LORD strong and mighty, Jehovah mighty in battle.
- Psalms 76, 11 Make vows to the LORD your God and fulfill them; let all that are round about him bring presents unto him that is to be feared.
- Isaiah 6, 3 Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; the whole earth is full of his glory!
- Isaiah 64, 4 Never have men heard, nor perceived by the ear, nor has eye seen a **God** besides you, **who acts** on behalf of him who waits for him.
- Jeremiah 23, 6 He will be called: The LORD our Righteousness.
- Daniel 12, 7 Him who lives forever.

The Angel of the LORD

Jesus

- Exodus 3, 1-2 The Angel of the LORD appeared to Moses in flames of fire from within a bush. Moses saw that though the bush was on fire, it did not burn up.
- Genesis 21, 17 The Angel of God called to Hagar from heaven and said to her: “Fear not; for God has heard the voice of the lad.”
- Genesis 32, 30 Jacob called the name of the place Peniel (Face of God), “For I have seen God face to face and my life has been preserved.”
- Numbers 22, 23 The donkey saw the Angel of the LORD standing in the way, his sword drawn in his hand.
- 2 Chronicles 20, 6 LORD, God of our fathers, are you not the God (*the Same*) who is in heaven? You rule over all the kingdoms of the nations. Power and might are in your hand, no one can withstand you.
- Psalm 34, 7
Isaiah 63, 9 The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear him, and he delivers them. In all their affliction he was afflicted and the Angel of his presence saved them.
- Jeremiah 23, 29 Is not my word like a fire, declares the LORD; and like a hammer that breaks a rock in pieces?
- Malachi 3, 1 & 2 The Angel of the covenant, whom you delight in, will come. He will be like a refiner’s fire, and like fullers’ lye.
- Hebrews 12, 29 Our God is a consuming fire.
- Revelation 1, 15 His voice is as the voice of many waters.
- Revelation 10, 1-3 I saw another strong angel coming down from heaven, clothed with a cloud and the rainbow upon his head, his countenance as the sun and his feet as pillars of fire. He set his right foot on the sea and the left on the land and cried with a loud voice as a lion roars.

The LORD Will Provide

Jesus

- Genesis 22, 14 Abraham called the name of that place the LORD Will Provide, Jehovah-Jireh, as it is said at the present day, "On the mountain of the LORD it will be provided." My son, God himself will provide the lamb for the burnt offering.
- Genesis 22, 8
- Genesis 31, 42 If the God of my father, the God of Abraham, and the Fear of Isaac, had not been with me!
- Exodus 15, 26 I am the LORD who heals you.
- Jeremiah 17, 13 LORD, you are the Hope of Israel, the spring of living water.
- Daniel 2, 17 & 18 Daniel urged his friends to plead for mercy from the God of heaven (*Aramaic: Elah*).
- John 3, 16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his one and only Son, that whosoever believes in him will not perish, but have eternal life.
- John 4, 10 & 11 If you knew the gift of God, and who it is that asks you for a drink, you would have asked of him, and he would have given you living water. "Sir, where can you get this living water?"
- Acts 17, 25 He himself gives everyone life and breath and all things.
- 2 Corinthians 9, 8 God is able to bless you abundantly, so that, having in every way always all sufficiency, you will abound in every good work.
- 2 Corinthians 9, 15 Thanks be to God for his unspeakable gift.
- Hebrews 10, 10 We have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. He has said, "I will not leave you, neither will I forsake you."
- Hebrews 13, 5
- 1 Peter 1, 18 & 19-20 You have been redeemed by precious blood, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot, the blood of Christ, foreknown indeed before the foundation of the world.

The Almighty *Jesus*

- Revelation 19, 6 Hallelujah, for the Lord our God the Almighty has taken to himself kingly power.
- Genesis 35, 11 I am the Almighty God (El-Shaddai).
- Job 9, 4 He is wise in heart and mighty in strength: who has hardened himself against him and had peace?
- Jeremiah 32, 27 Behold, I am the LORD, the God of all humankind: is there anything too hard for me?
- Matthew 14, 25 & 27 Jesus went out to the disciples, walking on the lake. "Take courage! It is I. Don't be afraid."
- Matthew 16, 9 Do you still don't understand? Don't you remember the five loaves for the five thousand, and how many basketfuls you gathered?
- Matthew 19, 25-26 "Who then can be saved?" Jesus, looking on them, said to them, "With men this is impossible; but with God all things are possible."
- Mark 4, 39 & 41 He rebuked the wind and said to the waves, "Quiet; be still!" The wind died down and there was a great calm. They said one to another, "Who then is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?"
- Luke 1, 37 Nothing shall be impossible with God.
- Luke 3, 8 God is able out of these stones to raise up children to Abraham.
- Romans 4, 21 Being fully persuaded that what God has promised he is able also to do.
- Ephesians 3, 20 He is able to do far exceedingly above all we ask or think.

The Rock *Jesus*

- 1 Corinthians 10, 4 They drank of a spiritual rock which followed them: the Rock was the Christ.
- Exodus 33, 21-22 There is a place near me where you may stand on the rock; when my glory passes by, I will put you in a cleft of the rock.
- Numbers 20, 8 & 11 Speak to the rock and it will pour out its water. Much water came out and the assembly drank.
- 2 Samuel 22, 47 The LORD lives! Blessed be my Rock! Exalted be my God, the Rock of my salvation.
- Psalm 61, 2
Psalm 62, 7 Lead me to the rock that is too high for me (*or that is higher than I*). God is the rock of my strength.
- Psalm 71, 3 Be to me a rock of habitation.
- Psalm 78, 20 Moses struck the rock and water gushed out, and streams overflowed.
- Psalm 94, 22 The rock of my refuge.
- Isaiah 2, 10 Enter into the rock and hide in the dust, before the terror of the LORD and the glory of his majesty.
- Isaiah 26, 4 In Jah, Jehovah, is the Rock of ages (*the Rock eternal*).
- Matthew 7, 24 Whoever therefore hears my words and does them, I will liken him to a prudent man, who built his house on the rock.
- Matthew 16, 16 & 18 You are the Christ, the Son of the living God. On this rock I will build my church, and Hades' gates will not prevail against it.
- John 4, 14 Whoever drinks of the water which I shall give him will never thirst forever, but the water which I shall give him will become in him a fountain of water, springing up into eternal life.

A Strong Tower

Jesus

- Proverbs 18, 10 The name of the LORD is a Strong Tower the righteous runs to it and is safe (*or is unapproachable, literally is set in a high retreat*).
- 1 Samuel 15, 29 The Hope (or the Glory) of Israel will not lie nor repent (*change his mind*).
- 2 Samuel 22, 33 God is my strong fortress.
Psalm 10, 14 You are the helper of the fatherless.
- Psalm 27, 5 In the day of trouble he will hide me in his pavilion; in the secret of his tent will he keep me concealed.
- Psalm 32, 7 You are a hiding place for me; you will protect me from trouble and surround me with songs of deliverance.
- Isaiah 19, 20 The Egyptians will cry out to the LORD because of their oppressors and he will send them a savior and defender (*a great one*).
- Isaiah 25, 4 You have been a fortress for the poor, a refuge for the needy in his distress, a shelter from the storm, a shade from the heat: for the blast of the terrible ones has been as the storm driving against a wall.
- Isaiah 32, 2 A man will be as a hiding place from the wind, and a covert from the storm; as brooks of water in a dry place, as the shadow of a great rock in a thirsty land.
- Joel 3, 16 The LORD will be a shelter for his people, and the stronghold (*refuge*) of the children of Israel.
- Colossians 3, 3 Your life is now hidden with Christ in God.
- Revelation 7, 15-16 He who sits on the throne will spread his tabernacle over them. Never again will they hunger, never again will they thirst, nor will the sun at all fall on them, nor any burning heat.



Waiting for the Messiah



For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but it hastes to the end,

The Deliverer *Jesus*

- Romans 11, 26 As it is written: the Deliverer (*literally*: the One who saves) will come from Zion.
- Exodus 3, 7 & 8 I have indeed seen the affliction of my people; and I have come down to deliver them.
- Isaiah 49, 25 Even the captive of the mighty will be taken away and the prey of the fierce will be delivered.
- Isaiah 61, 1 The LORD has anointed me to proclaim liberty to the captives and opening of the prison to them that are bound.
- Jonah 2, 9 Salvation comes from the LORD.
- Matthew 6, 13 Save us from evil.
- Luke 1, 68-69 Blessed be the LORD the God of Israel, because he has visited and wrought redemption for his people and raised up a horn of deliverance for us.
- John 8, 34 Jesus answered them, "Very truly I tell you, everyone that sins is a slave to sin."
- John 8, 36 "If the Son sets you free, you will be really free."
- Romans 7, 24-25 What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body of death? I thank God, (*who delivers me*) through Jesus Christ our Lord.
- 1 Thessalonians 1, 10 Jesus, our deliverer from the coming wrath.
- Philemon 8-9 Therefore having much boldness in Christ, for love's sake I rather exhort.
- Hebrews 2, 14-15 That through death he might break him who has (*or 'who had' literally 'having' without reference to time*) the might of death, that is, the devil and free those who all their lives were held in slavery by their fear of death.

My Redeemer Jesus

- Job 19, 25 I know that my Redeemer lives.
- Ruth 3, 9 Spread the corner of your garment (*or your wing*) over me, since you are a guardian-redeemer of our family.
- Ruth 4, 14 Blessed be the LORD who has not left you this day without one that has the right of redemption!
- Psalms 31, 5 You have redeemed me, LORD, you, God of truth.
- Psalms 111, 9 He provided redemption for his people.
- Psalms 130, 8 He will redeem (*ransom*) Israel from all his sins.
- Proverbs 23, 10-11 Remove not the ancient landmark and enter not into the fields of the fatherless: for their Redeemer is mighty; he will plead their cause against you.
- Isaiah 43, 1 Do not fear, for I have redeemed you, I have called you by your name; you are mine.
- Isaiah 63, 4 The day of vengeance was in my heart, and the year of my redeemed had come.
- Isaiah 63, 16 Our Redeemer from everlasting is your name.
- Romans 3, 24 Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus.
- Galatians 3, 13 Christ has redeemed (*to buy out from*) us out of the curse of the law, having become a curse for us.
- Hebrews 9, 11 & 12 Christ, by his own blood, has entered, once for all, into the holy of holies, having found an eternal redemption.
- Revelation 5, 9 You were slain and with your blood, you bought for God, persons from every tribe, language, people and nation.

The Arm of the LORD

Jesus

- Isaiah 51, 9 Awake, awake, Arm of the LORD clothe yourself with strength!
- Exodus 15, 6 Your right hand, LORD, is glorious in power: Your right hand, LORD, has dashed in pieces the enemy.
- Deuteronomy 7, 18 & 19 Remember well the powerful hand and outstretched arm with which the LORD your God brought you out.
- Deuteronomy 33, 27 The eternal God (*God of old*) is your refuge, and underneath are the everlasting arms (*eternal arms*).
- Psalms 89, 13 Yours is the arm of might: strong is your hand, high is your right hand.
- Isaiah 30, 30 The LORD will cause the majesty of his voice to be heard, and will show the lightning down of his arm.
- Isaiah 52, 10 The LORD will lay bare his holy arm in the sight of all the nations and all the ends of the earth will see the salvation of our God. Who has believed our report and to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?
- Isaiah 59, 1 Surely, the LORD's hand is not shortened that it cannot save, neither his ear too dull that it cannot hear. He wondered that there was no intercessor; so his own arm achieved salvation for him and his own righteousness sustained him.
- Isaiah 59, 16
- Isaiah 62, 8 The LORD has sworn by his right hand and by the arm of his strength.
- Mark 10, 15-16 Truly I tell you, anyone who will not receive the kingdom of God like a little child, will in no wise enter it. He took the children in his arms, placed his hands on them and blessed them (*abundantly*).
- Luke 1, 51 He has performed mighty deeds with his arm.

Your Shield Jesus

Genesis 15, 1	Fear not, I am your Shield and your exceeding great reward.
Exodus 17, 15	Moses built an altar and called it: Jehovah-Nissi (the LORD my Banner).
Exodus 33, 12 & 14 (Note: Deuteronomy 4, 37)	You have not let me know whom you will send with me. The Lord said, "My Presence (<i>countenance: in revealing himself</i>) will go with you and I will give you rest."
Deuteronomy 33, 29	The shield of your help and the sword of your excellency.
2 Samuel 22, 3	In him will I trust, my shield and the horn of my salvation, my high tower and my refuge.
Psalms 40, 17	You are my help.
Psalms 139, 5	You hem me in behind and before and you lay your hand upon me.
Song of songs 5, 10	My beloved is radiant and ruddy, the chiefest (<i>lifted up as a banner</i>) among ten thousand.
Isaiah 33, 6	He will be the stability of your times, the riches of salvation, wisdom and knowledge: the fear of the LORD will be your treasure.
Isaiah 59, 19	When the adversary will come in like a flood, the Spirit of the LORD will lift up a banner against him.
John 14, 1	Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in me.
Ephesians 6, 13 & 16	Take up the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the inflamed darts of the wicked one.
Hebrews 11, 6	Without faith it is impossible to please God, because everyone that draws near to God must believe that he exists and that he is a rewarder of them who earnestly seek him.

Wonderful, Counselor

Jesus

Isaiah 9, 6b, c

He will be called: Wonderful, Counselor.

Judges 13, 18

The Angel of the LORD said to Manoah, “Why do you ask my name? It is beyond understanding (*wonderful*).”

Psalms 68, 5

God is a father to the fatherless and a defender of the widows.

O knowledge too wonderful for me! It is high, I cannot attain it.

Psalms 139, 6

They would not accept my counsel (*advise*).

Proverbs 1, 30

It is the LORD’s purpose that prevails.

Proverbs 19, 21

Does the farmer plow all day to sow? His God instructs him in his judgment, he teaches him. This also comes from the LORD of hosts; he is wonderful in counsel, great in wisdom.

Isaiah 28, 24 & 26 & 29

Who has measured the waters in the hollow of his hand? Who has directed the Spirit of the LORD, and, as his counsellor, has taught him? All the nations are as nothing before him.

Isaiah 40, 12 & 13

Isaiah 40, 17

In a little while I will again shake the heavens and the earth, and the desire of all nations will come.

Haggai 2, 6 & 7

It is not the will of your Father (*literally: there is no will before your Father*) who is in heaven that any of these little ones should perish.

Matthew 18, 14

Hebrews 6, 17

Because God, willing to show more abundantly to the heirs of the promise the unchangeableness of his purpose, he intervened by an oath.

Revelation 3, 18

I counsel you to buy from me gold purified by fire, white garments, that you may be clothed and salve to anoint your eyes, that you may see.

Our Lawgiver *Jesus*

Isaiah 33, 22

The LORD is our Lawgiver.

Exodus 31, 18

The LORD gave to Moses the two tablets of the covenant law, the tablets of stone, written with the finger of God.

Psalms 19, 7a

The law of the LORD is perfect, restoring the soul.

Jeremiah 31, 33

I will put my law in their minds and write it on their hearts; I will be their God and they will be my people.

Matthew 7, 12

All things whatever you desire that men should do to you, this also do to them; for this is the law and the prophets.

Matthew 22, 37

Matthew 22, 39-40

Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul and with all your understanding. Love your neighbor as yourself. On these two commandments the whole law and the prophets hang.

Luke 16, 17

It is easier for heaven and earth to pass away than for the least stroke of a pen to drop out of the law.

Romans 3, 20

Through the law we become conscious of our sin.

Romans 10, 4

Christ is the end of law for righteousness to everyone who believes.

Romans 13, 1 & 4

There is no authority except that which God has established. The one in authority is God's servant for your good.

Romans 13, 8

Whoever loves others has fulfilled the law.

James 1, 25

He that fixes his view on the perfect law, that of liberty, and abides in it, being not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, he will be blessed in his doing.

James 4, 12

There is only one Lawgiver and Judge, the one who is able to save and destroy.

The Branch *Jesus*

Zechariah 3, 8

I will bring forth my servant the Branch (*the Sprout*).

Genesis 3, 15

I will put enmity between you (*the serpent*) and the woman, and between your offspring (*seed*) and hers; he (*the offspring of the woman*) will crush your head and you will strike his heel.

Isaiah 4, 2

In that day there will be a Sprout of the LORD for beauty and glory, and the fruit of the earth for excellency.

Isaiah 11, 10

There will be a Root of Jesse (*'Jesse' means 'Jah exists'*), standing as a banner of the peoples: the nations will seek it.

Isaiah 53, 2

He will grow up before him like a tender sapling and like a root out of dry ground.

Jeremiah 23, 5

I will raise up for David a righteous Branch, who will reign as king, act wisely and execute judgment and righteousness.

Ezekiel 34, 29

I will raise up for them a plant of renown.

Zechariah 6, 12

Here is the man whose name is the Branch; he will grow up from his own place and he will build the temple of the LORD.

John 12, 24

Very truly I tell you, unless the kernel of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains only a single seed; but if it dies, it bears much fruit.

Galatians 3, 16

The promises were addressed to Abraham and to his seed, it says: 'to your seed,' meaning one person, who is Christ.

1 Peter 1, 23



My Strength Jesus

- Habakkuk 3, 19 The Sovereign Lord (Jehovah Adonai) is my Strength, he makes my feet like the feet of a deer, he will make me walk upon my high places.
- Exodus 15, 2 Jah, (*this name expresses his absolute existence*) the LORD is my strength and song.
- Psalm 8, 1-2 LORD, our Lord, how excellent is your name in all the earth! You have set your majesty above the heavens. Out of the mouth of infants and sucklings, you have established praise (*or founded strength*) because of your enemies, to silence the foe and the avenger.
- Psalm 27, 1b The LORD is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid? The Mighty One of Jacob! Arise, LORD, and come to your resting place, you and the ark of your strength!
- Psalm 132, 5 & 8
- Jeremiah 10, 6 Your name is mighty in power.
- Habakkuk 3, 3-4 His glory covers the heavens, and the earth is full of his praise. His brightness was as the light; rays flashed from his hand, there was the hiding of his power.
- Habakkuk 3, 18 I will rejoice in the LORD, I will be joyful in God my Savior.
- 2 Corinthians 2, 14 God always leads us in triumph in Christ.
- Ephesians 1, 18a & 19-20 So that you may know the surpassing greatness of his power towards us who believe, according to the working of the might of his strength, which he exerted in the Christ in raising him from the dead.
- 2 Thessalonians 1, 9b-10 From the glory of his might, on the day he will come to be glorified in his saints and to be marveled at among all those who have believed.
- Revelation 3, 21 I have overcome and sat down with my Father on his throne.
- Revelation 6, 2 He rode out as a conqueror bent on conquest.

The Head *Jesus*

- 1 Chronicles 29, 11 Yours, LORD, is the kingdom and you are exalted as Head above all.
- Genesis 49, 10 The scepter will not depart from Judah, nor the lawgiver (*or staff of command*) from between his feet (*from his descendants*), until Shiloh comes, to him will be the obedience of peoples.
- Joshua 5, 15 The captain of the LORD's army said to Joshua, "Take off your sandals for the place where you are standing is holy."
- Psalms 18, 1 To the chief Musician (*or for the director of music*).
- Isaiah 55, 4b I have made him a ruler and commander to the peoples.
- Matthew 2, 6
Micah 5, 2, & 4 You, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are not at all the least among the governors of Judah; for out of you will come a leader who will shepherd my people Israel.
- 1 Corinthians 11, 3 Christ is the head of every man (*in contrast with woman*).
- Ephesians 1, 22 God has put all things under his feet and appointed him to be head over everything for the church.
- Ephesians 4, 15 That, holding the truth in love, we may grow up to him in all things, who is the head, the Christ.
- Colossians 2, 10 You are complete in him, who is the head over every power and authority.
- Colossians 2, 19 The head, from whom the whole body, ministered to and united together by the joints and bands, increases with the increase of God.
- Hebrews 2, 10
Hebrews 12, 2 The leader of their salvation (*or the pioneer*).
Looking steadfastly (*looking away from other things and fixing the eye exclusively on one*) on Jesus the leader (he began and finished the whole course) and completer (perfecter) of faith (*or 'to make perfect'*).
- (Note: Hebrews 2, 10)

The Prince of Peace

Jesus

- Isaiah 9, 6a,f & 7 The government will be on his shoulders and he will be called Prince of Peace. Of the increase of his government and peace there will be no end.
- Judges 6, 24 Gideon built an altar to the LORD there and called it Jehovah-Shalom (the LORD of Peace).
- Ezekiel 37, 25 David my servant will be their prince forever.
- Daniel 8, 23 & 25 A fierce-looking king, a master of intrigue, will take his stand against the Prince of princes: but he will be broken without hand.
- Micah 5, 1 & 4-5 The judge of Israel will stand and feed his flock in the strength of the LORD, in the majesty of the name of the LORD his God. They will live securely; for then his greatness will reach to the ends of the earth. This man will be Peace.
- Zechariah 9, 10 The battle bow will be broken. He will proclaim peace to the nations; his rule will extend from sea to sea and from the river (*the Euphrates*) to the ends of the earth.
- Luke 2, 13-14 Suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host, praising God and saying, "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good pleasure in men."
- Luke 24, 36 Jesus himself stood among them and said, "Peace be with you."
- Acts 3, 15 You killed the originator of life, but God raised him from the dead.
- Romans 15, 13 May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.
- 2 Thessalonians 3, 16 May the Lord of peace himself give you peace continually in every way.
- Revelation 1, 5b The prince of the kings of the earth.

The King of Kings

Jesus

- Revelation 19, 16 On his robe and on his thigh he has this name written King of kings and Lord of lords.
- Psalms 45, 6 Your throne, O God, will last for ever and ever; a scepter of justice will be the scepter of your kingdom.
- Proverbs 21, 1 The king's heart is in the LORD's hand as a stream of water that he channels toward all who please him (*whithersoever he will*).
- Isaiah 33, 17 Your eyes will see the King in his beauty.
- Daniel 2, 20-21 Praise be to the name of God for ever and ever; for wisdom and might are his. It is he that changes times and seasons (*or appointed times*); he deposes kings and raises up others.
- Daniel 7, 13-14 There came with the clouds of heaven one (human being) like a son of man. He came up even to (*he reached unto*) the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him. There was given him dominion, glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations and languages should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, that will not pass away, and his kingdom will never be destroyed.
- Zechariah 9, 9 See, your King comes to you: he is just and having salvation; lowly and riding on a donkey.
- Zechariah 14, 9a The LORD will be king over the all earth.
- Luke 2, 25 Simeon was waiting for the consolation of Israel.
- Matthew 2, 2 "Where is the king of the Jews that has been born? We saw his star in the east and have come to worship him."
- John 1, 49 Nathanael declared, "Rabbi, you are the King of Israel."
- Revelation 15, 3 Righteous and true are your ways, O King of the nations.

The True God *Jesus*

- 1 John 5, 20b Jesus Christ is the True God and eternal life.
- Genesis 33, 20 Jacob set up an altar and called it El-Elohe-Israel (God, the God of Israel).
- Isaiah 9, 6d He will be called Mighty God (El: the Mighty).
(Note: Genesis 14, 18)
- Daniel 2, 46 & 47 The king Nebuchadnezzar fell on his face and said to Daniel, "Surely your God is the God of gods and the Lord of kings and a revealer of secrets."
- John 10, 30 & 33 I and the Father are one. The Jews answered Jesus, "We are not stoning you for any good work, but for blasphemy, because you, a mere man, make yourself God."
- John 20, 28 Thomas said to him, "My Lord and my God!"
- Acts 14, 15 The living God, who made the heavens, the earth, the sea and everything in them.
- Romans 9, 5 Christ (*or the Messiah*), who is over all, God blessed for ever.
- 2 Corinthians 5, 19 God was in Christ, reconciling the world to himself, not counting people's sins against them.
- Philippians 2, 5-6 Christ Jesus, who, being in the form God (*or in very nature God*), did not esteem it an object of rapine to be on an equality with God.
- Colossians 2, 9 In Christ dwells all the fullness of Deity (Godhead) in bodily form.
- 1 Timothy 3, 16 The mystery from which true godliness springs is great: God has been manifested in flesh, has been justified in the Spirit, has appeared to angels, has been preached among the nations, has been believed on in the world, has been received up in glory.

The Glory of God

Jesus

- 2 Corinthians 4, 6 God made his light shine in our hearts for the shining forth of the knowledge of the Glory of God in the face of Christ.
- Exodus 24, 17 The appearance of the glory of the LORD was like a consuming fire on top of the mountain.
- Leviticus 16, 2 I will appear in the cloud upon the mercy seat.
- Numbers 14, 21 All the earth will be filled with the glory of the LORD!
- 2 Chronicles 5, 13-14 The house of the LORD was filled with a cloud and the priests could not stand to do their service because of the cloud; for the glory of the LORD had filled the house of God.
- Psalms 29, 3 The God of glory thunders.
- Psalms 29, 9a The voice of the LORD makes the deer give birth.
- Isaiah 40, 5 The glory of the LORD will be revealed and all people will see it together.
- Isaiah 58, 8 The glory of the LORD will be your rearguard.
- Ezekiel 1, 26 & 27-28 A likeness as the appearance of a man was high above on the throne. It had brightness round about. Like the appearance of a rainbow in the clouds on a rainy day. This was the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the LORD.
- Luke 9, 29 As Jesus was praying the fashion of his countenance (*face*) became different and his clothes became as bright as a flash of lightning.
- 2 Corinthians 3, 18 We all, who with unveiled faces contemplate the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his image from glory to glory, even as by the Lord the Spirit.
- Titus 2, 13 While we wait for the blessed hope and appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ.



Unto us a child is born



Unto us a son is given.

Isaiah 9, 6

Immanuel *Jesus*

- Matthew 1, 23 The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, they will call him Immanuel which means God with us.
- 1 Chronicles 16, 27 Majesty and splendor are before him; strength and gladness are in his dwelling place.
- Psalms 138, 6 Though the LORD is exalted, he looks kindly on the lowly and he knows the proud from afar.
- Jeremiah 20, 11 The LORD is with me as a mighty terrible one; therefore my persecutors will stumble and will not prevail.
- Ezekiel 48, 35 The name of the city from that time on will be: the LORD is there (Jehovah-Shamma).
- Zephaniah 3, 17 The LORD your God is with you, the Mighty Warrior who saves: he will rejoice over you with joy; he will rest in his love; he will exult over you with singing.
- Haggai 2, 5 The word that I covenanted with you when you came out of Egypt, and my Spirit, remain among you: fear not.
- Matthew 18, 20 Where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I in the midst of them.
- John 14, 23 If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, my Father will love him and we will come to him and make our home with him.
- 2 Corinthians 3, 17 Where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom.
- 2 Corinthians 13, 11 The God of love and peace will be with you.
- Revelation 21, 3 God's dwelling place is now with men, and he will dwell with them, they will be his people, God himself will be with them and be their God.

Jesus

Jesus

- Matthew 1, 20a & 21 Mary will give birth to a son and you are to give him the name Jesus because he will save his people from their sins.
- Exodus 20, 7 You shall not idly (*or for an untruth*) utter the name of the LORD your God; for the LORD will not hold anyone guiltless who misuses his name.
- Song of songs 1, 3 Your name is an ointment poured forth.
- Matthew 18, 5 Whoever welcomes one such little child in my name, welcomes me.
- Mark 9, 41 Anyone who gives you a cup of water to drink in my name, because you belong to the Christ, truly I tell you, he will in no wise lose his reward.
- Luke 21, 12 You will be brought before kings and governors because of my name. You will be hated of all for my name's sake.
- Luke 21, 17
- John 14, 13 Whatever you will ask in my name, this will I do.
- Acts 2, 22 Jesus of Nazareth was a man accredited by God to you by works of power, wonders and signs, which God did among you through him.
- Acts 2, 38 Repent and be baptized, each one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ, for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.
- Acts 4, 12 Salvation is in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to humankind by which we must be saved.
- Acts 9, 5 I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting.
- Acts 19, 17 The name of the Lord Jesus was magnified.
- Revelation 1, 1 Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave him, to show his servants what must soon take place.

A Unique Son

Jesus

- John 1, 14b We have contemplated his glory, a glory as of a Unique Son who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.
- Ezekiel 34, 23 I will place (*raise up*) one shepherd over my flock.
- Zechariah 12, 10b The inhabitants of Jerusalem will mourn for him, as one mourns for an only son.
- Zechariah 14, 9b In that day there will be one LORD, and his name one.
- Matthew 11, 27 All things have been committed to me by my Father, and no one knows the Son except the Father, nor does anyone know the Father, but the Son, and he to whom the Son may be pleased to reveal him.
- Matthew 17, 1 & 8 Lifting up their eyes, Peter, James and John saw no one but Jesus alone.
- Mark 12, 6 Having yet therefore one beloved son, he sent also him to them the last, saying, "They will have respect for my son."
- John 1, 18 No one has ever seen God, at any time; the only begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, has made him known.
- John 3, 18 He that believes in him is not judged: but he that does not believe, stands condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son.
- 1 Corinthians 8, 4 We know that an idol is nothing in the world and that there is no God but one.
- Galatians 3, 20 God is one.
- 2 John, 3 Grace, mercy and peace from God the Father and from the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, will be with you in truth and love.

The Son of God

Jesus

Luke 1, 35 & 32a

The angel answered, “The Holy one to be born will be called Son of God. He will be great and will be called Son of the Highest (Elyon).

Psalms 2, 7

You are my Son; today I have begotten you.

Daniel 3, 25

The king said, “Look! I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt; the appearance of the fourth is like a son of God.”

John 1, 32a & 34

John bore witness, saying, “This is the Son of God.”

Mark 3, 11

When the unclean spirits saw him, they fell down before him and cried out, “You are the Son of God.”

Matthew 14, 33

Those who were in the boat worshiped him, saying, “Truly you are God’s Son.”

Matthew 17, 5

A bright cloud overshadowed them, and a voice out of the cloud said, “This is my beloved Son, in whom I have found my delight: listen to him.”

John 5, 20

The Father loves the Son and shows him all things which he himself does; and he will show him greater works than these, so that you will be amazed.

Matthew 27, 40b

“If you are the Son of God, come down from the cross!”

Matthew 27, 54

When the centurion and those with him who were guarding Jesus, saw the earthquake and the things that took place, they feared greatly, and exclaimed, “Surely this man was the Son of God!”

Romans 8, 31 & 32

God did not spare his own Son.

1 John 3, 8

The Son of God has been manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil. Who is he that gets the victory over the world, but he that believes that Jesus is the Son of God.

1 John 5, 5

The Image of God

Jesus

- 2 Corinthians 4, 4 The radiancy of the good news of the glory of Christ, who is the Image of God.
- Genesis 16, 13 & 14 You are the God who reveals himself (*literally 'of the being seen' or 'of the vision'*). Therefore the well was named Beer Lahai Roi (*well of the Living who sees me or who reveals himself*).
- Exodus 24, 9 & 10 Moses, Aaron, Nadab, Abihu and the seventy elders of Israel saw the God of Israel; there was under his feet as it were work of transparent sapphire and the form of heaven for clearness.
- Exodus 33, 20 The LORD said, "You cannot see my face; for no one may see me and live."
- Numbers 12, 7 & 8 Moses sees the form of the LORD.
- Deuteronomy 4, 15-16 You saw no form the day that the LORD spoke to you at Horeb out of the fire, lest you corrupt yourselves and make for yourselves a graven image.
- John 4, 24 God is spirit; and they who worship him must worship him in spirit and truth.
- John 12, 44 & 45 Jesus cried out: "He that beholds me, beholds him that sent me."
- 1 Corinthians 15, 49 As we have borne the image of the one made of dust, we shall bear also the image of the heavenly one.
- Colossians 1, 13 & 15a The kingdom of the Son of his love: who is image of the invisible God.
- 1 Timothy 6, 15 & 16 The blessed and only Ruler lives in unapproachable light; whom no man has seen, nor is able to see.
- Hebrews 1, 2 & 3a & c The Son, who being the effulgence of his glory and the expression of his substance (essential being of God), sat himself down on the right hand of the greatness on high.

The Beloved *Jesus*

- Ephesians 1, 6 He has taken us into favor in the Beloved.
- Psalm 42, 8 His song will be with me, a prayer to the God of my life.
- Psalm 109, 1 O God of my praise, be not silent.
- Song of songs 2, 1 I am a narcissus of Sharon, a lily of the valleys.
- Song of songs 2, 16 My beloved is mine and I am his.
- Matthew 10, 37 & 38 & 39 He who loves father or mother above me is not worthy of me; he who does not take up his cross and follow me is not worthy of me. He who has lost his life for my sake will find it.
- Luke 7, 37 & 38 A woman in the city, who was a sinner, standing at Jesus' feet behind him weeping, began to wash his feet with tears; then she wiped them with her hair, (*ardently*) kissed his feet and poured perfume on them.
- Luke 10, 39 Mary, having sat down at the feet of Jesus, was listening to his word.
- John 3, 27 & 30 John said, "He must increase, but I must decrease."
- John 17, 24 (& 25) You loved me before the creation of the world, Righteous Father!
- 1 Corinthians 16, 22 If anyone does not love the Lord Jesus Christ, let him be cursed (*anathema*). Maran-atha (*the Lord comes*)!
- Ephesians 6, 24 Grace to all who love our Lord Jesus Christ with an undying love.
- 2 Timothy 1, 13 Faith and love which are in Christ Jesus.
- 2 Peter 1, 17 Jesus received from God the Father honor and glory, when such a voice being uttered to him by the excellent glory, (*from the Majestic Glory*), "This is my beloved Son, in whom I have found my delight."

His Anointed *Jesus*

Psalm 2, 2 & 6

The kings of the earth rise up and the princes plot together against the LORD and against his Anointed. "I have anointed my king upon Zion, the hill of my holiness."

Exodus 30, 23 & 25

Take best spices and make of it an oil of holy ointment, a perfume of perfumery after the work of the perfumer.

1 Kings 17, 16

The flour in the jar was not used up, neither did the oil in the jug fail, according to the word of the LORD.

Psalm 23, 5

You have anointed my head with oil; my cup overflows.

Psalm 92, 10

I shall be anointed (mingled, *it is not merely 'anointed' but his whole system is invigorated and strengthened by it*) with fresh oil.

Note: Leviticus 2, 4

Daniel 9, 24b

To anoint the Holy of holies (*or the Most Holy One*).

Matthew 1, 20b

What is conceived in Mary is of the Holy Spirit.

John 1, 32

John bore witness, saying, "I saw the Spirit come down from heaven as a dove and remain on him."

Luke 4, 18 & 19

The Spirit of the LORD is on me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor and to preach the acceptable year of the LORD. Today this scripture is fulfilled.

Isaiah 61, 1 & 2

Luke 4, 21

Acts 4, 27

Indeed Herod and Pontius Pilate met together with the nations and the people of Israel in this city to conspire against your holy servant Jesus, whom you anointed.

Acts 10, 38

God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power; he went through all quarters doing good and healing all that were under the power of the devil, because God was with him.

Hebrews 1, 9

Psalm 45, 7

You have loved righteousness and hated lawlessness; therefore God, your God, has anointed you with oil of gladness above your companions.

The Messiah

Jesus

- John 1, 41 We have found the Messiah which means Christ (the Anointed One).
- Isaiah 25, 7-8 On this mountain he will destroy the shroud that enfolds all peoples, the covering that is spread over all the nations. He will swallow up death in victory (*or forever*).
- Daniel 9, 25 & 26 From the going forth of the word to restore and to build Jerusalem until Messiah, the Prince, comes, are seven weeks and sixty-two weeks. After the Messiah will be cut off and will have nothing.
- Luke 2, 11 Today a Savior has been born to you in David's city, who is Christ the Lord.
- John 4, 25 & 26 The woman said, "I know that Messiah is coming, who is called Christ; when he comes he will tell us all things." Jesus said to her, "I who speak to you, I am he."
- Matthew 23, 10
Luke 9, 20 Neither be called instructors, for one is your instructor, the Christ. The Christ of God (God's Messiah)!
- Mark 14, 61-62 The high priest asked Jesus, "Are you the Christ, the Son of the Blessed One?" and Jesus said, "I am."
- John 20, 31
Acts 2, 36 These signs are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God. God has made this Jesus whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ.
- Acts 9, 20 & 22 At once Saul began to preach in the synagogues that Jesus is the Son of God, proving that Jesus is the Christ (*Messiah*).
- Hebrews 2, 5
Note: Titus 2, 13-13
Hebrews 6, 5 It is not to angels that he subjected the habitable world which is to come, of which we speak (*what was to be introduced by the Messiah. It was for the Jews the present state of things in contrast with that to be introduced by the Messiah.*) The works of power of the age to come.

The Lamb of God

Jesus

- John 1, 29 John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, “Look, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!”
- Exodus 12, 5 & 8 Your lamb must be without defect (*it must be perfect*), a year-old male. That night they are to eat the meat, roasted over the fire, along with bitter herbs and bread made without yeast. It is the LORD’s Passover (*the action of passing over*).
- Exodus 12, 11
- Exodus 34, 20 No one is to appear before me empty-handed.
- Isaiah 53, 7 He was led like a lamb to the slaughter, and was as a sheep dumb before her shearers, so he did not open his mouth.
- Acts 8, 35 Philip began with this very passage of Scripture and told the good news of Jesus to the Ethiopian eunuch.
- 1 Corinthians 5, 7 Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed.
- Revelation 5, 6 I saw a Lamb, looking as if it had been slain, standing in the midst of the throne, encircled by the four living creatures and the elders. The Lamb had seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent out into all the earth.
- Revelation 7, 9 & 10 A great crowd, that no one could number. They cried out in a loud voice, “Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb.” They have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.
- Revelation 7, 14
- Revelation 12, 10 & 11 Our brothers and sisters have overcome the accuser by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony.
- Revelation 13, 8 The book of life of the slain Lamb.
- Revelation 14, 1 Behold the Lamb standing on Mount Zion.
- Revelation 17, 12 & 14 Ten kings with the beast will wage war against the Lamb, but the Lamb will triumph over them because he is Lord of lords and King of kings.

The Son of Man

Jesus

- John 6, 53 Unless you eat the flesh of the Son of man and drink his blood, you have no life in you.
- Exodus 26, 31 & 33 Make a curtain of blue, purple and scarlet yarn and finely twisted linen. Place the ark of the covenant law behind the curtain.
- Matthew 9, 6
Note John 10, 18 The Son of man has authority (*Greek: exousia, right to act as well as power*) on earth to forgive sins.
- Matthew 12, 40 The Son of man will be in the heart of the earth three days and three nights.
- Luke 18, 8 When the Son of man comes, will he indeed find faith on the earth?
- Luke 19, 10 The Son of man came to seek and to save that which is lost.
- John 1, 51 You will see the heaven open and the angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of man.
- John 3, 13 No one has gone up into heaven, except he who came down out of heaven, the Son of man who is in heaven.
- John 5, 27 The Father has given him authority to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man.
- Matthew 27, 51 The curtain of the temple was torn in two from the top to the bottom.
- Galatians 4, 4 & 5 When the fulness of the time has come, God sent his Son, born (come) of a woman, born (come) under the law, that we might receive adoption to sonship.
- Hebrews 10, 5 & 7
Psalm 40, 6-7 "You prepared a body for me. Here I come to do, O God, your will."
- Hebrews 10, 20b The veil, that is, his flesh (*or 'body'*).

The Son of David

Jesus

- Matthew 1, 1 This is the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the Son of David, the son of Abraham.
- 1 Samuel 13, 14 The LORD has sought out a man after his own heart.
- 1 Samuel 16, 11-13 Samuel asked Jesse, "Are these all the young men?" Jesse answered, "There is still the youngest, he is tending the sheep." The LORD said, "Rise and anoint him; this is the one." The Spirit of the LORD came upon David (*Beloved*).
- Psalm 89, 3-4 I have made a covenant with my chosen one, I have sworn to David my servant: "I will establish your line for ever, and build up your throne from generation to generation."
- Psalm 132, 17 There will I cause the horn of David to bud forth.
- Matthew 9, 27 & 30 Two blind men followed Jesus, calling out, "Have mercy on us, Son of David!" and their eyes were opened.
- Matthew 12, 22 & 23 Then was brought to him a demon possessed man, who was blind and mute, and Jesus healed him. All the people were astonished and said, "Is this man the Son of David?"
- Matthew 21, 9 & 15 The crowds and the children shouted in the temple, "Hosanna (*save now*) to the Son of David!"
- Mark 12, 35 & 37 Jesus asked, "Why do the teachers of the law say that the Christ is the son of David? David himself calls him Lord, how then can he be his son?"
- Luke 1, 32b The Lord God will give him the throne of his father David.
- John 7, 42 Does not the scripture say that the Christ will come from David's descendants and from the village of Bethlehem?
- Romans 1, 3 His Son, who as to his earthly life was a descendant of David.
- Revelation 3, 7b The words of him who holds the key of David.

The One Man Jesus

- Romans 5, 15 The gift in grace, which is by the one Man Jesus Christ, abounded to the many.
- Psalms 45, 3 Gird your sword on your thigh, you mighty one, in your majesty and your splendor.
- Luke 2, 12 You will find a baby wrapped in cloths and lying in a manger.
- Matthew 2, 20 They who sought the life of the little child are dead.
- Luke 2, 42 & 46-47 When Jesus was twelve years old, his parents found him in the temple, sitting among the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions. Everyone who heard him was astonished at his understanding and his answers.
- Luke 3, 23 Jesus himself was about thirty years old when he began his ministry; being as was supposed son of Joseph.
- Luke 22, 44 Being in anguish, he prayed more intently. His sweat became as great drops of blood, falling down upon the earth.
- Luke 23, 4 Pilate said, "I find no guilt in this man."
- Luke 23, 47 The centurion, seeing what took place, glorified God, saying, "In very deed this man was just."
- 1 Corinthians 15, 45 & 47 The first man Adam became a living soul; the last Adam a quickening spirit (*making alive*). The first man was of the dust of the earth, made of dust; the second man is of heaven.
- 1 Timothy 2, 5b-6 The man Christ Jesus, who gave himself as a ransom for all.
- Hebrews 5, 8
Hebrews 12, 3 Though he was Son, he learned obedience from the things which he suffered. Consider well him who endured such great contradiction from sinners against himself.
- 2 John, 7 Many deceivers do not confess Jesus Christ coming in the flesh. Any such person is the deceiver and the antichrist.



The life of Jesus on earth



Jesus went through all quarters doing good and healing all that were under the power of the devil, because God was with him.

Acts 10, 38

A Messenger Jesus

Isaiah 41, 27

I will give a Messenger of good news.

Isaiah 42, 19 & 20 & 21

Who is blind as he in whom I have trusted (he who is perfect), seeing many things and paying no attention? He has magnified the law and made it honorable.

Isaiah 52, 7

How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of him who brings good news, who publishes peace.

Mark 1, 15

The time is fulfilled and the kingdom of God has come near; repent and believe in the glad tidings.

Luke 12, 49-50

I have come to cast a fire on the earth; and what will I if already it has been kindled? I have a baptism to be baptized with and what constraint I am under until it is accomplished!

John 3, 17

God did not send his Son into the world that he may judge the world, but that the world may be saved through him.

John 4, 34

My food is to do the will of him who sent me and to finish his work. This is the work of God, that you believe in him whom he has sent.

John 6, 29

John 8, 29

The one who sent me is with me; he has not left me alone, because I do always the things that are pleasing to him.

John 10, 36 & 38

Do you say of him whom the Father has sanctified and sent into the world, "You blaspheme," because I said, "I am Son of God?" Believe the works.

John 12, 49

I did not speak on my own, but the Father who sent me commanded me to say all that I have spoken.

Romans 8, 3-4

God, having sent his own Son, in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin (*as a sacrifice for sin*), has condemned sin in the flesh, so that the righteous requirement of the law should be fulfilled in us.

Your Holy Servant *Jesus*

- Acts 4, 30 Stretch out your hand to heal and that signs and wonders take place through the name of your Holy Servant Jesus.
- Exodus 21, 5-6 If a servant declares distinctly, “I love my master, my wife and my children, I do not want to go free.” Then his master will take him to the door and pierce his ear with an awl; and he will be his servant for life.
- Psalms 40, 8 To do your good pleasure, my God, is my delight and your law is within my heart.
- Isaiah 42, 1 Here is my servant, whom I uphold, my chosen one in whom my soul delights! I will put my Spirit on him; he will bring judgment (*justice*) to the nations.
- Isaiah 53, 11 He will see of the fruit of the travail of his soul and be satisfied: by his knowledge my righteous servant will instruct many (*those that are in relationship with him*) in righteousness; and he will bear their iniquities.
- Matthew 20, 28 The Son of man came, not to be served, but to serve.
- Mark 7, 37 He does all things well.
- Mark 11, 15 Entering into the temple, he began to cast out those who were buying and selling there.
- Luke 5, 16 Jesus often withdrew to lonely places and prayed.
- Luke 22, 27 For who is greater, the one who is at the table or the one who serves? Is it not the one who is at the table? Yet I am among you as the one who serves.
- John 13, 3 & 5 Jesus began to wash the feet of the disciples and to wipe them with the linen towel with which he was girded.
- Philippians 2, 5 & 7 Christ Jesus emptied himself (*made himself of no reputation*), taking a slave’s form, becoming in the likeness of men.

Your Holy One *Jesus*

- Psalm 16, 10 You will not let your Holy One see decay.
- Isaiah 10, 17 & 23 The Light of Israel will be a fire and his Holy One a flame. The Lord, Jehovah of hosts, will accomplish in the midst of all the land a consumption, and one determined (*the judgments preceding Messiah's reign*).
- Isaiah 12, 6 Cry out and shout, you inhabitant of Zion; for great is the Holy One of Israel among you.
- Habakkuk 1, 12 & 13 Are you not from everlasting, the LORD my God, my Holy One? Your eyes are too pure to look on evil.
- John 6, 69 You are the Holy One of God.
- John 14, 30 The ruler of the world comes, and in me he has nothing.
- Acts 3, 14 You denied the Holy and Righteous One and asked that a murderer be released (*or be granted*) to you.
- 1 Timothy 1, 17 Now to the King of the ages, the incorruptible, invisible, only God, be honor and glory for ever and ever!
- Hebrews 7, 26 He is holy, blameless, undefiled, separated from sinners and has become higher than the heavens.
- James 1, 13 God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does he tempt anyone.
- 1 John 3, 5 In him sin is not.
- Revelation 15, 4
(Note: 2 Chronicles 6, 42) Who will not fear you, O Lord, and glorify your name, for you only are holy (*Hebrew: Chasid; saint. It is goodness in God, piety in man towards God, or one's parents, lovingkindness and mercy. Christ himself, as the One in whom these qualities are found, is called 'Chasid' Holy One*); for all nations will come and worship before you; for your righteous acts have been revealed.

The Carpenter *Jesus*

- Mark 6, 3 Isn't this the Carpenter, the son of Mary and brother of James, Joses, Judas and Simon?
- Genesis 6, 13 & 14 God said to Noah, "Make yourself an ark of gopher wood."
- Exodus 25, 1 & 9 The LORD said to Moses, "Make this tabernacle and all its furnishings exactly like the pattern I will show you."
- Exodus 31, 2 & 3-4 I have called by name Bezaleel and I have filled him with the spirit of God, with wisdom, understanding, knowledge and with all kind of skills, to devise artistic work.
- Ezekiel 40, 2-3 On a very high mountain was as the building of a city, on the south. The LORD took me there and behold, there was a man whose appearance was like the appearance of brass, with a linen cord and a measuring rod in his hand.
- Matthew 3, 12 His winnowing fork is in his hand and he will thoroughly purge his threshing floor, gathering his wheat into the barn, but the chaff he will burn with fire unquenchable.
- Luke 4, 23 You will surely say to me this parable, "Physician, heal yourself!"
- Matthew 13, 55 & 56 "Isn't this the son of the carpenter? Aren't all his sisters with us? Where then did this man get all these things?"
- John 7, 5 Even his own brothers did not believe in him.
- Luke 8, 21 My mother and my brothers are those who hear the word of God and put it into practice.
- Matthew 27, 40a "You who are going to destroy the temple and build it in three days, save yourself!"
- Revelation 21, 16 The city (*the new Jerusalem*) was laid out like a square: the length, the breadth and height of it are equal.

A Nazarene Jesus

Matthew 2, 23

He will be called a **Nazarene**.

Numbers 6, 2 & 5 & 8

If a man or a woman have vowed the special vow of a Nazarite (*or Nazirite: consecration, separation*), to dedicate themselves to the LORD, he will be holy (*or consecrated*) to the LORD.

Luke 2, 49

“Why is it that you have sought me? Didn’t you know that I ought to be occupied in my Father’s business?”

John 1, 46

“Nazareth! Can anything good come out from there?”

Mark 10, 46 & 47 & 50

Bartimaeus, the blind man, having heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, jumped to his feet and came to Jesus.

Matthew 21, 10-11

As Jesus entered Jerusalem, the whole city was stirred and asked, “Who is this?” The crowds answered, “This is Jesus the prophet who is from Nazareth of Galilee.”

John 18, 3 & 4-5 & 6

“Who is it you seek?” The band replied, “Jesus the Nazarene.” Jesus said to them, “I am he.” When therefore he said to them, “I am he,” they went away backward and fell to the ground.

Matthew 26, 69

Peter was sitting out in the courtyard and a servant girl came to him, saying, “You also were with Jesus the Galilean.”

John 19, 19

Pilate wrote a title also and put it on the cross. There was written: **Jesus the Nazarene, the King of the Jews.**

Luke 24, 32

“Was not our heart burning within us as he spoke to us on the way and as he opened the scriptures to us?”

Acts 3, 6

In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.

Hebrews 13, 12-13

Jesus, that he might sanctify the people by his own blood, suffered outside the city gate. Let us, then, go to him outside the camp, bearing the disgrace he bore.

The Prophet *Jesus*

- John 6, 14 Surely this is the Prophet who is to come into the world.
- Deuteronomy 18, 18 I will raise up for them a prophet like you.
Ezekiel 2, 5 Whether they listen or fail to listen, they will know that a prophet has been among them.
- Amos 3, 7 The Sovereign Lord will do nothing, without revealing his secret to his servants the prophets.
- Zechariah 13, 5 & 6 He will say, "I am not a prophet." If someone asks, "What are these wounds on your hands?" he will answer, "Those with which I was wounded in the house of my friends."
- Luke 7, 16 Fear seized them all and they glorified God, saying, "A great prophet has been raised up among us."
- Matthew 13, 57 A prophet is not without honor, except in his country and in his house.
- Matthew 21, 46 Seeking to lay hold of him, the chief priests and the Pharisees were afraid of the crowds, because they held him for a prophet.
- Luke 13, 33 Surely no prophet can die outside Jerusalem.
- Matthew 24, 23-24 If anyone says to you, "Look, here is the Christ," or "There he is," do not believe it. For there will arise false christs and false prophets, they will perform great signs and wonders, to deceive, if possible, even the elect.
- Luke 24, 19 Jesus of Nazareth was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people.
- John 7, 15 The Jews were amazed and asked, "How did this man get such learning without having been taught?"
- John 7, 46 No one ever spoke the way this man speaks.

Our Only Master *Jesus*


- Jude, 4 Our only Master and Lord Jesus Christ.
- Matthew 7, 28-29 When Jesus had finished these words, the crowds were astonished at his doctrine, for he taught them as having authority, and not as their teachers of the law.
- Mark 13, 35 Watch therefore, for you do not know when the master of the house (*or owner*) will come back.
- Luke 5, 5 “Master, (*one who is over the others*) we’ve worked hard all night and haven’t caught anything, but at your word I will let down the nets.”
- Luke 6, 5 The Son of man is Lord of the Sabbath also.
- Luke 8, 24 “Master, master, we perish.” He, rising up, rebuked the wind and the raging waters; the storm subsided and all was calm.
- John 3, 2 Nicodemus came to Jesus at night and said to him, “Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher who has come from God.”
- John 13, 13 You call me Teacher and Lord, and rightly so, for that is what I am.
- John 20, 16 Jesus said to her, “Mary.” She, turning toward him, and cried out, “Rabboni!” (which means Teacher).
- Ephesians 6, 9 He who is both their Master and your’s is in heaven, and there is no favoritism with him.
- James 5, 4 The cries of those who have reaped and whose wages are wrongly kept back, have reached the ears of the Lord of sabaoth (*the LORD of hosts*).
- 2 Peter 2, 1
(Note: 1 Corinthians 11, 19
& Galatians 5, 20) There will be also among you false teachers, who will secretly introduce destructive heresies (*sects, schools or parties after a man’s own opinion*), and deny the master who bought them, bringing swift destruction on themselves.

Lord of All Jesus

- Acts 10, 36 Jesus Christ is Lord of all.
- Joshua 3, 11 The ark of the covenant of the Lord of all the earth will go into the Jordan ahead of you.
- Psalms 2, 4 & 2 He that dwells in the heavens will laugh, the Lord (*Hebrew: Adonai*) will have the kings of the earth and the princes in derision.
- Matthew 8, 8-9 & 10 The centurion replied, "Lord, I do not deserve to have you under my roof; but only speak a word (*literally: with or by a word*) and my servant will be healed. For I also am a man under authority, having under me soldiers, and I say to this one, "Go," and he goes; and to another, "Come," and he comes; and to my servant, "Do this," and he does it. Jesus said, "I have not found anyone in Israel with such great faith."
- Mark 5, 28 The woman thought, "If I just touch his clothes, I will be healed."
- John 3, 31 He who comes from above is above all.
- Romans 10, 12 & 13 The same Lord of all is rich towards all who call on him. "For everyone whosoever, who will call on the name of the Lord, will be saved."
- Joel 2, 32
- Romans 14, 9 For this very reason, Christ has died and lived again, so that he might be Lord over both the dead and the living.
- 1 Corinthians 2, 7 & 8 God's wisdom which none of the rulers of this age understood, for had they known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.
- Ephesians 4, 4 & 5 There is one Lord, one faith, one baptism.
- 1 Peter 3, 21-22 Jesus Christ has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God, angels, authorities and powers are subjected to him.
- Revelation 19, 12a On his head are many diadems.

John 7, 38

The Bread of Life

Jesus

- John 6, 35 Jesus said to them, "I am the Bread of life whoever comes to me will never (*at any time*) go hungry."
- Leviticus 2, 5 Your grain offering is to be made of the finest flour mixed with
Leviticus 2, 13 oil and without yeast. Do not leave the salt of the covenant of your God out of your grain offering.
- Judges 7, 13 I had a dream: a round loaf of barley bread tumbled into the tent; it struck it with such force that the tent overturned and collapsed.
- Matthew 4, 4 Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that
Deuteronomy 8, 3 comes from the mouth of God.
- Matthew 6, 11 Give us today our needed bread (*daily bread*).
- Luke 24, 35 The two disciples related how Jesus was made known to them in the breaking of bread (*was recognized by them when he broke the bread*).
- John 6, 32-33 My Father gives you the true bread from heaven. For the bread of God is he who comes down out of heaven and gives life to the world.
- 1 Corinthians 5, 8 Let us celebrate the feast with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.
- 1 Corinthians 11, 24 This is my body, which is for you: this do in remembrance of me (*an act of significance of 'recalling' or 'calling to mind' as a memorial*). As often as you will eat this bread and drink the cup, you announce the death of the Lord until he comes.
- 1 Corinthians 11, 26
- Hebrews 5, 14 Solid food belongs to fullgrown men, who, as a result of habit, have their senses trained to distinguish both good and evil.
- Hebrews 9, 4 The golden jar that had the manna.
- Revelation 2, 17a To him that overcomes will I give of the hidden manna.

The Light of the World

Jesus

- John 8, 12 Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the Light of the world. He that follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."
- Numbers 6, 25 & 26 The LORD make his face shine on you and be gracious to you; the LORD lift up his countenance on you and give you peace.
- Psalms 104, 2 The LORD wraps himself with light as with a garment.
- Psalms 119, 105 Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light on my path.
- Psalms 119, 130 The entrance of your words gives light, it gives understanding to the simple.
- Psalms 139, 12 Even darkness hides not from you and the night shines as the day: the darkness is as the light to you.
- Isaiah 9, 2 The people that walked in darkness have seen a great light; they that lived in the land of the shadow of death, upon them light has shone.
- Isaiah 42, 6b I will make you a light of the nations.
- John 1, 5 The light appears in darkness and the darkness has not understood it. The true light was that which, coming into the world, lightens every man (or *'is light to every man' not 'enlightens', but 'sheds its light upon'*).
- John 1, 9
- 1 Peter 2, 9 You are a chosen race, a kingly priesthood, a holy nation, a people for a possession, that you may set forth the excellencies of him who has called you out of darkness to his wonderful light.
- Exodus 19, 6
- 1 John 1, 5 God is light, in him there is no darkness at all.
- 1 John 2, 8 The darkness is passing and the true light already shines.
- Revelation 21, 24 The nations will walk by its light.

The Door of the Sheep

Jesus

John 10, 7	Very truly, I tell you, "I am the Door of the sheep."
Exodus 12, 7	They are to take some of the blood and put it on the sides and tops of the door frames of the houses where they eat the lamb.
Exodus 12, 23	The LORD will pass over that doorway and will not permit the destroyer to enter your houses and strike you down.
Deuteronomy 15, 17	Take an awl and thrust it through your servant's earlobe into the door; and he will become your servant for life.
Psalms 118, 20	This is the gate of the LORD: the righteous will enter therein.
Matthew 7, 13	Enter through the narrow gate.
Matthew 25, 10	The bridegroom arrived and the virgins who were ready went in with him to the wedding feast, and the door was shut.
John 10, 1	Anyone who does not enter the sheep pen by the gate, but climbs in by some other way, is a thief and a robber.
John 10, 9	I am the door: if anyone enters in through me, he will be saved, and will go in and go out, and find pasture.
Acts 14, 27	God had opened a door of faith to the nations.
James 5, 9	The Judge is standing at the door.
Revelation 3, 8	I have set before you an opened door that no one can shut.
Revelation 4, 1	I saw a door standing open in heaven.
Revelation 21, 21	The twelve gates were twelve pearls; each one of the gates, respectively, was of one pearl; the street of the city was of pure gold, as transparent glass.
Revelation 21, 25	Its gates will not be shut at all by day, for there will be no night there.

The Good Shepherd

Jesus

- John 10, 11 I am the good Shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.
- Psalm 23, 4 Your rod and your staff, they comfort me.
- Psalm 80, 1 Hear us, Shepherd of Israel, you who sit enthroned between *(or dwell above)* the cherubim, shine forth!
- Isaiah 40, 11 He will feed his flock like a shepherd: he will gather the lambs in his arm and carry them close to his heart; he will gently lead those that give suck.
- Zechariah 13, 7 Awake, sword, against my shepherd, even against the man that is my fellow, declares the LORD of hosts: strike the shepherd, and the sheep will be scattered.
- Matthew 9, 36 When he saw the crowds he was moved with compassion for them.
- Matthew 18, 12 If a man owns a hundred sheep and one of them goes astray, will he not leave the ninety-nine on the hills and go to look for the one that wandered off?
- John 10, 3 & 14 & 16 He calls his own sheep by name. I know my sheep and my sheep know me. There will be one flock and one shepherd.
- John 17, 12 Those you have given me I have guarded and not one of them has perished.
- Hebrews 13, 20 The God of peace brought back from the dead our Lord Jesus, the great Shepherd of the sheep, in the power of the blood of the eternal covenant.
- 1 Peter 2, 25
1 Peter 5, 4 You have now returned to the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls. When the Chief Shepherd is manifested you will receive the unfading crown of glory.

The Resurrection

Jesus

- John 11, 25 Jesus said to her, "I am the Resurrection and the life: the one who believes in me, though he has died, will live."
- 1 Kings 17, 22 The LORD heard the voice of Elijah, and the soul of the child came into him again, and he lived.
- Matthew 22, 32 "I am the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob." God is not God of the dead, but of the living.
- Mark 5, 39-40 & 41-42 "The child is not dead, but asleep." They laughed at him. Jesus took her by the hand and said to her "Talitha koumi," which means "Little girl, I say to you, get up!" Immediately the girl stood up and began to walk around.
- John 5, 25 A time has now come when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God and those who have heard will live.
- John 10, 17 & 18 I lay down my life. No one takes it from me. I have authority to lay it down and authority to take it up again.
- John 11, 26 Everyone who lives and believes in me will never die.
- Luke 24, 5 "Why do you seek the living one among the dead?"
- Luke 24, 34 The Lord is indeed risen.
- Acts 4, 2 They were preaching by Jesus the resurrection of the dead.
- 1 Corinthians 15, 22 As in Adam all die, so in the Christ all will be made alive.
- Philippians 3, 8 & 10 I count also all things to be loss, that I may gain Christ and know him, and the power of his resurrection.
- Revelation 20, 5 & 13 The rest of the dead did not live until the thousand years had been completed. This is the first resurrection. Death and Hades (*the temporary place or state of the soul separated from the body*) gave up the dead that were in them; and they were judged each according to their works.
- (Note: Matthew 11, 23 & Psalm 6, 5)

Our Life Jesus

- Colossians 3, 4 Christ, who is our Life is manifested.
- Psalm 36, 9 With you is the fountain of life.
- John 1, 4 In him was life, and that life was the light of humankind.
John 1, 16 Of his fullness we all have received grace upon grace.
- John 3, 3 Except anyone be born anew (*not only 'again' but entirely afresh, as from a new source of life and point of departure*) he cannot see the kingdom of God.
- John 6, 40 This is the will of my Father, that everyone who sees (*beholds*) the Son and believes in him will have eternal life.
- John 6, 57 As the living Father has sent me and I live because of the Father, he who eats me will live also because of me.
- John 6, 63 The words I have spoken to you are spirit and life.
- John 17, 3 This is eternal life, that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent.
- 2 Timothy 1, 10 Our Savior Jesus Christ has annulled death and brought to light life and incorruptibility through the gospel.
- Hebrews 7, 15 & 16 A different priest arises according to power of indissoluble (indestructible) life.
- 1 John 5, 12 He who has the Son has life: he who does not have the Son of God does not have life.
- Revelation 1, 17-18 I am the First and the Last, I am the Living One: I was dead, and now look, I am alive for ever and ever. I hold the keys of death and Hades.
- Revelation 2, 7 To him that overcomes, I will give the right to eat from the tree of life, which is in the paradise of God.
- Revelation 21, 6 To the thirsty I will give water without cost from the spring of the water of life.

The Truth *Jesus*

- John 8, 32 You will know the Truth and the truth will set you free.
- 2 Samuel 7, 28 Lord LORD, you are that God (*you are the Same*), and your words are true (*literally truth*).
- John 1, 17 Grace and truth subsists (*came*) through Jesus Christ.
- John 6, 55 My flesh is truly (*real*) food and my blood is truly (*real*) drink.
- John 8, 23 & 25 Jesus said, "I am not of this world." The Jews asked him, "Who are you?" Jesus said to them, "Altogether that which I also say to you (*in the principle and universality of what I am, his speech presented himself, being the truth*)."
- John 17, 17 Sanctify them by the truth: your word (logos) is truth.
- John 18, 37-38 Jesus answered, "You say it, that I am a king. I have been born for this, and for this I have come into the world, that I might bear witness to the truth. Every one that is of the truth listens to me." Pilate retorted to him, "What is truth?"
- Ephesians 4, 21 The truth is in Jesus.
- 2 Thessalonians 2, 10 They have not received the love of the truth that they might be saved.
- James 1, 18 According to his own will, he gave us birth through the word of truth, that we might be a kind of firstfruits of his creatures.
- 1 John 2, 21 No lie comes from the truth.
- 3 John, 4 I have no greater joy than to hear that my children are walking in the truth.

The Way Jesus

- John 14, 6 Jesus says to him, “I am the Way the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.”
- Genesis 3, 24 After the LORD drove the man out, he set the Cherubim and the flame of the flashing sword, toward the east of the garden of Eden, to guard the way to the tree of life.
- Job 38, 19 Where is the way to where light dwells?
- Isaiah 11, 16 There will be a highway for the remnant of his people.
- Isaiah 30, 21 Your ears will hear a voice behind you, saying, “This is the way, walk in it.” A highway called the way of holiness will be there. Those who go this way, even fools, will not err therein.
- Isaiah 35, 8
- Nahum 1, 3b The LORD, his way is in the whirlwind and the storm, and clouds are the dust of his feet.
- Luke 1, 78 & 79 The dayspring from on high has visited us to guide our feet into the way of peace.
- Matthew 7, 14 Narrow is the gate and straitened the way that leads to life and they are few who find it.
- 1 Corinthians 12, 31 I will show you a way of more surpassing excellence.
- 1 Corinthians 13, 13 Now these three things remain: faith, hope and love; but the greatest of these is love.
- Ephesians 2, 17-18 Through Jesus Christ we have both (*those who are far away and those who are near*) access to the Father by one Spirit.
- Hebrews 10, 19-20a & 22 Therefore, brothers and sisters, since we have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus, by the new and living way which he has dedicated for us through the curtain, that is, his flesh (*body*), let us draw near with a true heart, in full assurance of faith.

The True Vine *Jesus*

- John 15, 1 I am the true Vine and my Father is the farmer.
- Isaiah 26, 12 LORD, you also have done all our works for us.
- Isaiah 46, 4 Even to your old age and grey hairs, I am HE, I am he who will carry you.
- John 15, 5 He who abides in me and I in him will bear much fruit; for without me you can do nothing.
- Acts 4, 13 Seeing the boldness of Peter and John, they recognised that they had been with Jesus.
- Romans 8, 35 & 38-39 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, neither angels, nor principalities, neither things present, nor things to come, nor powers, neither height, nor depth, nor any other creature, will be able to separate us from the love of God, that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- 1 Corinthians 1, 9 God has called you into the fellowship with his Son Jesus.
- 1 Corinthians 3, 7 Neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God who makes things grow.
- 1 Corinthians 6, 15 Your bodies are members of Christ.
- Ephesians 5, 9 The fruit of the light is in all goodness, righteousness and truth.
- Hebrews 13, 6
Psalms 118, 6 So that, taking courage, we may say, "The Lord is my helper, I will not be afraid."
- Revelation 3, 20 Behold, I stand at the door and am knocking; if anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with him, and he with me.



To him who loves us

Revelation 1, 5c

The Friend *Jesus*

- Proverbs 17, 17 The Friend loves always.
- James 2, 23 Abraham was called Friend of God.
- Exodus 33, 11 The LORD spoke with Moses face to face, as a man speaks with his friend.
- Psalms 25, 14 The secret (*the intimate or private communications*) of the LORD is with them that fear him, he makes his covenant known to them.
- Psalms 41, 9 Even my close friend (*the man of my peace*), someone I trusted, one who shared my bread, has lifted up his heel against me (*or has turned against me*).
- Song of songs 5, 16 "My beloved is altogether lovely."
- Haggai 2, 23 I will make you like my signet ring; for I have chosen you.
- Matthew 11, 19a The Son of man has come eating and drinking and they say, "Here is a glutton and a drunkard, a friend of tax collectors and of sinners."
- Matthew 20, 8 & 13 The lord of the vineyard answering said to one of them, "My friend, I am not being unfair to you. Didn't you agree with me to work for a denarius?"
- John 13, 1 Jesus loved his own who were in the world, he loved them to the end.
- John 15, 13-14 & 15 & 16 No one has greater love than this, that one should lay down his life for his friends. You are my friends if you practise whatever I command you. I have called you friends, for all things that I have heard from my Father I have made known to you. You have not chosen me, but I have chosen you.
- Matthew 26, 50 Jesus said to Judas, "My friend, for what purpose did you come?"

The Crucified One

Jesus

- Matthew 28, 5-6 You are looking for Jesus the Crucified One. He is not here, for he is risen.
- Deuteronomy 21, 23 He that is hanged is a curse of God.
- Psalm 22, 6 I am a worm and no man; a reproach of men and the despised of the people.
- Psalm 69, 8
Psalm 69, 21 I am become a foreigner, a stranger to my brothers and sisters and an alien to my mother's sons. They gave me gall (*a bitter and poisonous plant*) for my food and in my thirst they gave me vinegar to drink.
- Isaiah 52, 14 Many were astonished at you; his visage was so marred more than any man and his form beyond human likeness.
- Isaiah 53, 3 He was despised and left alone of men; a man of sorrows, acquainted with grief (*suffering*), like one from whom men hide their faces; he was despised and we esteemed him not.
- Zechariah 11, 12
Zechariah 12, 10a They weighed for my hire thirty pieces of silver.
They will look on me the one they have pierced.
- John 3, 14-15 As Moses lifted up the snake in the wilderness, so the Son of man must be lifted up, that everyone who believes in him may not perish, but have eternal life.
- Mark 14, 36 "Abba, Father, take away this cup from me."
- John 19, 2 A crown of thorns and a purple robe.
- Mark 15, 34 Jesus cried out in a loud voice, saying, "Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?" which is, being interpreted, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"
- Hebrews 2, 9 We see Jesus, who was made some little inferior to angels because of the suffering of death, now crowned with glory and honor.

The Propitiation *Jesus*

1 John 2, 1b-2

Jesus Christ, the Righteous One; he is the atoning sacrifice, the Propitiation for our sins; and not only for ours, but also for the whole world.

Exodus 25, 17

Make a mercy seat (*the lid or cover of the chest*) of pure gold.

Exodus 30, 15

The rich are not to give more and the poor are not to give less than a half shekel to make atonement for your souls (*lives*).

Leviticus 1, 4

He shall lay his hand on the head of the burnt offering; and it will be accepted for him to make atonement for him.

Leviticus 17, 11

It is the blood that makes atonement for (*or by*) the soul.

Job 33, 24b

Deliver him from going down to the pit: I have found a ransom (*or a propitiation*).

Romans 3, 24-25 & 26

(*Note: Romans 5, 16*)

Jesus, whom God has set forth a mercy seat, through faith in his blood, so that he should be just and justify (*judicial righteousness*) him that is of the faith of Jesus.

2 Corinthians 5, 21

Him who knew not sin God has made sin for us, that we might become God's righteousness in him.

Ephesians 5, 2

Christ loved us and gave himself up for us, an offering and sacrifice to God for a sweet smelling savor.

Colossians 2, 14-15

Having effaced (*used to annulling a decree of law*) the handwriting (*obligation to which a man is subject by his signature*) in ordinances which stood out against us, which was contrary to us, he has taken it away, having nailed it to the cross; having disarmed the principalities and authorities, he made a show of them publicly, triumphing over them by the cross.

Hebrews 9, 22

Without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness.

Hebrews 9, 26

Christ has appeared once for all at the culmination of ages to do away with sin by the sacrifice of himself. By one offering he has made perfect in perpetuity the sanctified (*having perfectly completed the work, he could sit down and abide so*).

Hebrews 10, 14

The Savior of the World

Jesus

John 4, 42

This man really is the Savior of the world.

Isaiah 53, 4 & 5

Surely he has borne our griefs, (*sickness*) and carried our sorrows. He was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him and by his wounds we are healed.

Daniel 3, 28

“Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego, who has sent his angel and delivered his servants who trusted in him.”

Luke 2, 30-32

My eyes have seen your salvation, which you have prepared in the sight of all nations; a light for revelation to the Gentiles and the glory of your people Israel.

John 19, 17-18

Jesus went out, bearing his cross, to the place called place of a skull, which is called in Hebrew, Golgotha; where they crucified him.

John 20, 27

He said to Thomas, “Bring your finger here and see my hands; reach out your hand and put it into my side.”

Acts 13, 23

According to promise has God brought to Israel a Savior.

Ephesians 5, 23

Christ is the head of the church, his body, of which He is the Savior.

1 Timothy 1, 15

1 Timothy 2, 3-4

1 Timothy 4, 10

Faithful is the word, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners. God our Savior wants that all men should be saved and come to the knowledge of the truth. We hope in a living God, who is preserver of all men, specially of those who believe.

Hebrews 8, 12

Jeremiah 31, 34

“I will forgive their wickedness, and their sins and lawlessnesses will I never (*or 'in no wise'*) remember any more.”

The Author of Eternal Salvation

Jesus

- Hebrews 5, 9 The Son became to all who obey him Author of eternal salvation.
- Exodus 32, 32 & 33 Your book that you have written. The LORD said to Moses, “Whoever has sinned against me, him I will blot out of my book.”
- Psalm 45, 1 My tongue is the pen of a skillful writer.
- Psalm 139, 16 In your book all my members (*or days*) were written.
- Habakkuk 2, 2 The LORD answered me and said, “Write the vision and engrave it on tablets, so that whoever reads it may run.”
- Malachi 3, 16 Those who feared the LORD spoke often one to another; and a book of remembrance was written before him.
- John 21, 25 There are also many other things which Jesus did, if they were written one by one, I suppose that not even the world itself would contain the books written.
- 2 Timothy 3, 15 & 16 The sacred letters. Every scripture is divinely inspired.
- 2 Peter 1, 21 Prophecy was not ever uttered by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke under the power of the Holy Spirit.
- Revelation 20, 12 Books were opened. The dead were judged out of the things written in the books according to their works.
- Revelation 20, 15 If anyone was not found written in the book of life, he was cast into the lake of fire.
- Revelation 21, 27 Nothing impure will ever enter the city nor anyone who does what is shameful or deceitful, but those only whose names are written in the book of life of the Lamb.
- Revelation 22, 19 If anyone takes words away from the book of this prophecy, God will take away his part from the tree of life.

It was not possible that Jesus should be held by the power of death.


Acts 2, 24

The Firstborn *Jesus*

- Hebrews 1, 6 When God brings in the Firstborn into the habitable world, he says, "Let all God's angels worship him."
- Psalms 89, 27 I will make him to be my firstborn Son, the highest of the kings of the earth.
- Isaiah 44, 6 I am the First and I am the Last and beside me there is no God.
- Matthew 28, 1 & 2 At dawn of the first day of the week, there was a great earthquake; for an angel of the Lord, descending out of heaven, came to the tomb and rolled away the stone.
- Acts 2, 24 It was not possible that Jesus should be held by the power of death.
- Acts 26, 22-23 The prophets and Moses said that the Christ would suffer and as the first, through resurrection of the dead, would announce light both to his own people and to the nations.
- Romans 8, 29 Those God foreknew he also predestinated to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters.
- 1 Corinthians 15, 20 Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep.
- Colossians 1, 15b & 18b He is the firstborn of all creation. He is the beginning and the firstborn from the dead, so that he might have the first place in all things.
- Hebrews 6, 19-20a Jesus entered within the veil as forerunner for us.
- 1 John 4, 19 We love because he has first loved us.
- Revelation 2, 8
Revelation 22, 12 These things says the First and the Last, who died and came to life again. "Look, I come quickly! (*I am coming soon!*) My reward is with me."



The ministry of Jesus in heaven



Jesus Christ sat down in perpetuity at the right hand of God.

Hebrews 10, 12

The Mediator

Jesus

- Hebrews 8, 6 Christ has got a more excellent ministry, by so much as he is the Mediator of a better covenant which is established on the footing of better promises.
- Job 33, 23-24a If there is a messenger with him, an interpreter, one among a thousand, to show to man his duty (*'uprightness' in judging himself*); then God will be gracious to him.
- Isaiah 42, 6a I will make you to be a covenant for the people.
Isaiah 53, 12 I will assign him a portion with the great, because he made intercession for the transgressors.
- Luke 22, 32 "I have prayed for you that your faith may not fail."
- Luke 23, 34 Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing."
- Romans 8, 33-34 Who will bring an accusation against God's elect? It is God who justifies. Who then is the one who condemns? It is Christ who intercedes for us.
- Ephesians 2, 14-15 He is our peace, who has destroyed the barrier, the dividing wall of hostility, by setting aside in his flesh the law.
- 1 Timothy 2, 5a There is one God and one mediator between God and humankind, the man Christ Jesus.
- Hebrews 7, 22 Jesus has become surety (guarantor) of a better covenant. He is able to save completely (*forever*) those who come to God through him, because he always lives to intercede for them.
- Hebrews 7, 25
- Hebrews 9, 24 Christ is not entered a sanctuary made with human hands, that was only a copy of the true one; he entered heaven itself, now to appear before the face of God for us.
- 1 John 2, 1a If anybody does sin, we have an advocate (*patron*) with the Father (*as 'comforter' one who carries on the cause of anyone and helps him, who maintains the interests of his clients in every way*).
- (Note: John 14, 16)

The Cornerstone

Jesus

Psalm 118, 22-23

The stone the builders rejected has become the Cornerstone; the LORD has done this, it is wonderful in our eyes.

1 Samuel 7, 12

Samuel took a stone and named it Eben-ezer (Stone of help), saying, "Thus far the LORD has helped us."

Isaiah 8, 13 & 14

The LORD of hosts is the one you are to regard as holy; let him be your fear and your dread. He will be a stone of stumbling and a rock of offence (*literally 'tottering' 'falling'*).

Daniel 2, 34

A rock was cut out, but not by human hands. It struck the statue on its feet of iron and clay and broke them to pieces.

Matthew 21, 42 & 44

The cornerstone. Anyone who falls on this stone will be broken, but on whomsoever it will fall, it will grind him to powder. Jesus Christ the Nazarene is the stone which has been set at nought by you the builders, which has become the head of the corner.

Acts 4, 10 & 11

Why has the people of Israel not attained their goal? Because it was not on the principle of faith, but as of works. They have stumbled over the stumbling stone.

Romans 9, 31-32

Colossians 1, 18a

He is the head of the body, the church.

1 Peter 2, 3-4

If indeed you have tasted that the Lord is good. As you come to him, a Living Stone, cast away indeed as worthless by men, but chosen by God and precious.

Revelation 2, 17b

To him that overcomes, I will give a white stone with a new name written on it, known only to the one who receives it.

Revelation 4, 2 & 3

The one who was sitting on the throne in heaven had the appearance of a stone of jasper and a sardius.

Revelation 21, 11

The shining of the holy city was like that of a precious jewel, as clear as crystal, like a jasper.

The Foundation *Jesus*

1 Corinthians 3, 11

No one can lay any foundation other than the Foundation already laid, which is Jesus Christ.

Ezra 3, 11

All the people gave a great shout of praise to the LORD, because the foundation of the house of the LORD was laid.

Psalms 87, 1 & 6

He has founded his city on the mountains of holiness. The LORD will count, when he inscribes the peoples, "This one was born there."

Isaiah 28, 16

I lay for foundation in Zion a stone, a tried stone, a precious cornerstone, a sure foundation (a foundation well founded): the one who relies on it will never be stricken with panic.

Isaiah 54, 11 & 14

I will lay your foundations with sapphires. You will be established in righteousness.

1 Corinthians 2, 2 & 5

I did not judge it well to know anything while I was with you except Jesus Christ and him crucified. So that your faith might not rest on human wisdom, but on God's power.

Ephesians 2, 19-20a

You are fellow citizens of the saints and of the household of God, being built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets.

Ephesians 3, 17

Be rooted and founded in love.

2 Timothy 2, 19

The firm foundation of God stands, having this seal, "The Lord knows those that are his."

Hebrews 6, 1

Let us go on to what belongs to full growth (*perfection*), not laying again a foundation.

1 Peter 5, 10

God himself will make perfect, establish, strengthen, ground.

Revelation 21, 14

The wall of the city had twelve foundations and on them were the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.

The Temple

Jesus

- Revelation 21, 22 The Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the Temple of the city.
- Genesis 35, 6 & 7 Jacob called the place El-Beth-El (God of the house of God).
- Psalm 29, 9b In the LORD's temple everyone says, "Glory!"
- Psalm 69, 9 The zeal for your house consumes me and the insults of those who insult you fall on me.
- Jonah 2, 7 My prayer rose to you, to your holy temple (*palace*).
- John 2, 19
John 2, 21 Jesus answered and said to the Jews, "Destroy this temple (*the house itself, the shrine*) and in three days I will raise it up." The temple he had spoken of was his body.
- John 14, 2 In my Father's house there are many abodes; I go to prepare you a place.
- Acts 17, 24 Being Lord of heaven and earth, God does not live in temples built by human hands.
- 2 Corinthians 6, 16 You are the temple of the living God.
- 2 Corinthians 6, 17
Isaiah 52, 11 Therefore, "Come out from them and be separate, says the Lord, touch not what is unclean and I will receive you."
- Ephesians 2, 20b-22 Jesus Christ himself being the chief cornerstone, in whom the whole building is joined and rises to become a holy temple in the Lord; in whom you also are built together for a habitation of God in the Spirit.
- 1 Timothy 3, 15 God's house is the assembly of the living God, the pillar and foundation of the truth.
- Revelation 11, 19 The temple of God in the heaven was opened and the ark of his covenant was seen in his temple.

The High Priest *Jesus*

- Hebrews 5, 5 & 10 Christ was designated by God to be High Priest according to the order of Melchisedek.
- Genesis 14, 18 Melchisedek was priest of the Most High God (El Elyon).
- Psalms 110, 4 The LORD has sworn, and will not repent, "You are a priest forever after the order of Melchisedek."
- Isaiah 1, 24 The Mighty One of Israel says: "Ah! I will avenge myself on my enemies."
- 1 Corinthians 15, 25-26 He must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet. The last enemy that is destroyed is death.
- Hebrews 2, 17 He (*when he became a man, historically*) had to be made like his brothers and sisters, fully human in every way, that he might become a merciful and faithful high priest.
- Hebrews 3, 1 Consider the Apostle and High Priest of our confession, Jesus,
- Hebrews 4, 14 who has gone through the heavens.
- Hebrews 4, 15 For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but he has been tempted in every way just as we are; yet he did not sin.
- Hebrews 6, 20b Jesus has become a high priest forever.
- Hebrews 7, 24 Because he lives forever, he has a permanent priesthood (*unchangeable or not transmitted to others*).
- Hebrews 7, 28 The word of the swearing of the oath which is after the law, appointed a Son who has been made perfect forever.
- Hebrews 8, 1-2 We have such a high priest who sat down at the right hand of the throne of the Greatness in the heavens; minister (an administrator officially employed) of the holy places and of the true tabernacle set up by the Lord.
- (Note: Romans 15, 16)
- Revelation 5, 14 The elders fell down and worshiped.

The Heir Jesus

Hebrews 1, 1 & 2	God has spoken to us in the person of the Son, whom he has established Heir of all things.
Psalms 2, 8	Ask me, and I will give you nations for an inheritance, and for your possession the ends of the earth.
Psalms 16, 6	The boundary lines have fallen for me in pleasant places; yea, I have a delightful heritage.
Mark 12, 7	The agriculturalists said to one another, "This is the heir: come, let us kill him and the inheritance will be ours."
John 6, 27	The Father has placed his seal of approval on the Son of man.
John 6, 37	All those the Father gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will not at all cast out. This is the will of him who sent me, that I shall lose none of all those he has given me.
John 6, 39	
John 16, 15	All that belongs to the Father is mine.
Matthew 28, 18	All power has been given to me in heaven and on earth.
Acts 1, 9	After he had said these things he was taken up, before their very eyes, and a cloud received him out of their sight.
Romans 8, 17	If we are children, we are heirs also: heirs of God and Christ's joint heirs.
Ephesians 1, 9-10	According to God's good pleasure, which he purposed in himself, to be put into effect when the times reach their fulfillment, to bring unity to all things in heaven and on earth under Christ. That you may know the riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people.
Ephesians 1, 18b	
Colossians 1, 12	Giving thanks to the Father, who has made us fit for sharing the portion (<i>inheritance</i>) of the saints in the kingdom of light.
1 Peter 1, 4	An incorruptible, undefiled and unfading inheritance, is reserved in the heavens for you.


The Faithful Witness

Revelation 1, 4b & 5a	Grace to you from Jesus Christ, who is the Faithful Witness.
Psalm 19, 7b	The testimony of the LORD is sure.
Isaiah 55, 4a	I have given him for a witness to the peoples.
Lam. of Jeremiah 3, 23	Great is your faithfulness!
Daniel 2, 22	It is he who reveals the deep and secret things.
Zechariah 4, 10	Who has despised the day of small things? These are the eyes of the LORD, that range throughout the whole earth.
Matthew 10, 26 & 28	There is nothing concealed that will not be revealed, or secret that will not be known. Do not be afraid of those who kill the body, but cannot kill the soul; but fear rather him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell (<i>the place of final and eternal torment, prepared for the devil and his angels</i>).
(Note: Matthew 11, 23)	
John 3, 12	If when I have spoken to you of earthly things, you do not believe, how, then will you believe if I speak of heavenly things? No one receives his testimony. Whoever has received his testimony has certified that God is truthful.
John 3, 32-33	
Acts 7, 56	I see the Son of man standing at the right hand of God.
2 Timothy 2, 13	If we are unfaithful, he remains faithful, for he cannot deny himself.
Revelation 6, 9-10	I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slain because of the word of God, and the testimony which they held, they cried with a loud voice, "O sovereign Ruler, holy and true, how long until you judge the inhabitants of the earth and avenge our blood?"
Revelation 19, 10	Worship God! For the spirit of prophecy is the testimony of Jesus.

The Bridegroom

Jesus

- Matthew 25, 6 In the middle of the night the cry rang out, "Here's the Bridegroom; come out to meet him."
- Ruth 3, 18 Naomi said, "The man will not rest until the matter is settled today."
- Esther 5, 2 The king held out to Esther the gold sceptre.
- Hosea 2, 19-20 I will betroth you to me forever; I will betroth you to me in righteousness and judgment, in lovingkindness and mercies; I will betroth you to me in faithfulness: and you will know the LORD.
- Matthew 13, 45-46 The kingdom of heaven is like a merchant seeking beautiful pearls; having found one pearl of great value, he went and sold all whatever he had and bought it.
- John 3, 29 The bride belongs to the bridegroom.
- 2 Corinthians 11, 2 I promised you to one husband, to Christ, so that I might present you as a chaste virgin to him.
- Ephesians 5, 25 & 27 Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her, that he might present her to himself glorious, having no spot, or wrinkle, or any of such things; but that she might be holy and blameless.
- Hebrews 10, 37-38 In just a very little while, "He who is coming will come and will not delay." The just will live by faith.
- Revelation 19, 7-8 The wedding of the Lamb has come and his bride has made herself ready; fine linen, bright and pure was given to her to wear.
- Revelation 21, 2 I saw the holy city, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. The Spirit and the bride say, "Come!"
- Revelation 22, 17

The Bright Morning Star

Jesus

- Revelation 22, 16 I, Jesus, am the Bright Morning Star.
- Numbers 24, 17 A star will come out of Jacob; a sceptre will rise out of Israel.
- Deuteronomy 33, 26
(Note: 32, 15) There is no one like the God of Jeshurun (*the upright people*), who rides on the clouds in his majesty.
- Matthew 24, 27 & 36 As the lightning goes from the east and shines to the west, so will be the coming of the Son of man. Of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, but my Father alone.
- John 14, 3 I am coming again and will receive you to myself.
- Acts 1, 11 This Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen him going into heaven.
- Romans 13, 11-12 Now is our salvation nearer than when we first believed. The night is nearly over; the day is near (*drawn nigh*).
- 1 Corinthians 15, 51-52
1 Thessalonians 4, 16-17 We will all be changed, in an instant, in the twinkling of an eye. The Lord himself will come down from heaven, with an assembling shout, with the archangel's voice and with the trumpet call of God; the dead in Christ will rise first; then we, who are still alive, will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air.
- 1 Timothy 6, 14-15 The appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ, which the blessed and only Ruler, the King of those who reign and the Lord of those who exercise lordship, will show in its own time.
- 2 Peter 1, 19 Until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts.
- Revelation 2, 26 & 28 To the one who does my will to the end, I will give the morning star.

The Sun of Righteousness

Jesus

- Malachi 4, 2 For you who fear my name the Sun of righteousness will rise with healing in his wings.
- Isaiah 11, 5-6 Righteousness will be his belt and faithfulness the sash around his waist. The wolf will live with the lamb and the young child will put its hand into the viper's nest.
- Isaiah 11, 8-9 They will not hurt nor destroy on all my holy mountain; for the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the LORD.
- Isaiah 26, 9 When your judgments come upon the earth, the inhabitants of the world learn righteousness.
- Amos 5, 24 Let judgment roll down as waters and righteousness as an ever flowing stream!
- Nahum 1, 3a The LORD is slow to anger and great in power, he does not at all clear the guilty.
- Habakkuk 3, 11 The sun and moon stood still in their habitation, at the light of your arrows which shot forth, at the shining of your glittering spear.
- Zephaniah 3, 5 Every morning he brings his judgment (*justice*) to light.
- Zechariah 14, 4 His feet will stand in that day on the Mount of Olives and the Mount of Olives will cleave in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west.
- Matthew 5, 6 Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled.
- Matthew 17, 2 His face shone like the sun.
- Revelation 20, 6 Blessed and holy are those who have part in the first resurrection: they will reign with Christ for a thousand years.
- Revelation 22, 2 The leaves of the tree are for the healing of the nations.

The Righteous Judge

Jesus

2 Timothy 4, 8

The crown of righteousness is laid up for me, which the Lord, the Righteous Judge will render to me on that day; and to all who love his appearing.

1 Samuel 2, 25

If one person sins against another, God will judge him (as an arbitrator); but if anyone sins against the LORD, who will intercede for him?

Psalms 89, 14

Righteousness and judgment are the foundation of your throne.

Daniel 9, 24a

Seventy weeks are decreed for your people and your holy city to bring in everlasting righteousness.

Obadiah, 15

The day of the LORD is near upon all the nations: as you have done, it will be done to you: your deeds will return upon your own head.

John 5, 22

The Father has given all judgment to the Son.

Acts 7, 52

Your ancestors even killed those who announced the coming of the Just One.

Acts 17, 30 & 31

God has set a day when he will judge the world with justice by the man he has appointed.

2 Thessalonians 1, 7-9a

The revelation of the Lord Jesus from heaven, with the angels of his power, in flaming fire taking vengeance on those who do not know God and do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus. They will pay the penalty of everlasting destruction.

Jude, 14-15

See, the Lord is coming amidst his holy myriads, to execute judgment against all.

Revelation 16, 5 & 7

You are just in these judgments, O Holy One, you who are and who were. Yes, Lord God Almighty, true and righteous are your judgments. I saw a great white throne and him who was seated on it (*'he that sits' is really a title, 'the sitter on the throne'*), from whose face the earth and the heaven fled, and place was not found for them.

Revelation 20, 11



The True One Jesus

- Revelation 3, 7a These things says the holy, the True One, he who opens and no one can shut, and shuts and no one can open.
- Psalm 72, 17 His name will endure forever, as long as the sun.
- Psalm 89, 2 You have established your faithfulness in heaven itself.
- Luke 23, 43 "Today you will be with me in paradise."
- 1 Corinthians 15, 28 When all things will have been made subject to him, then the Son also himself will be made subject to him who put everything under him, so that God may be all in all.
- 2 Corinthians 1, 19-20 Jesus Christ was not "Yes" and "No," but "Yes" is in him (*the verification of all divine truth is in the person of Christ*). For no matter how many promises God has made, in him is the "Yes" and in him the "Amen."
- 1 John 5, 20a The Son of God has come and has given us understanding so that we may know him who is true.
- Revelation 3, 14 The Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God (or the ruler of God's creation).
- Revelation 11, 15 The kingdom of the world of our Lord and of his Christ has come (*has now taken place, begun to be*).
- Revelation 19, 9 These are the true words of God.
- Revelation 19, 11 I saw heaven standing open and behold, a white horse whose rider is called Faithful and True.
- Revelation 21, 4 He will wipe away every tear from their eyes; death will not exist any more, nor grief, nor cry, nor distress will exist any more, for the former things have passed away.
- Revelation 21, 5 & 6 Behold, I make all things new. It is done.
- Revelation 22, 13 I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end. Yes, I come quickly.
